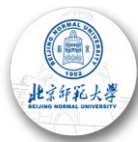
Welcome to BNBU

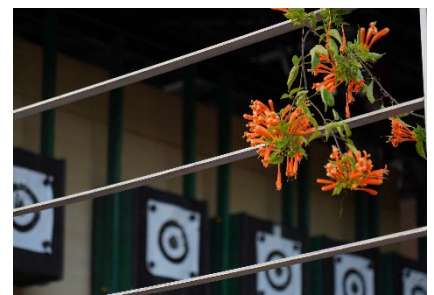

Where will you live?

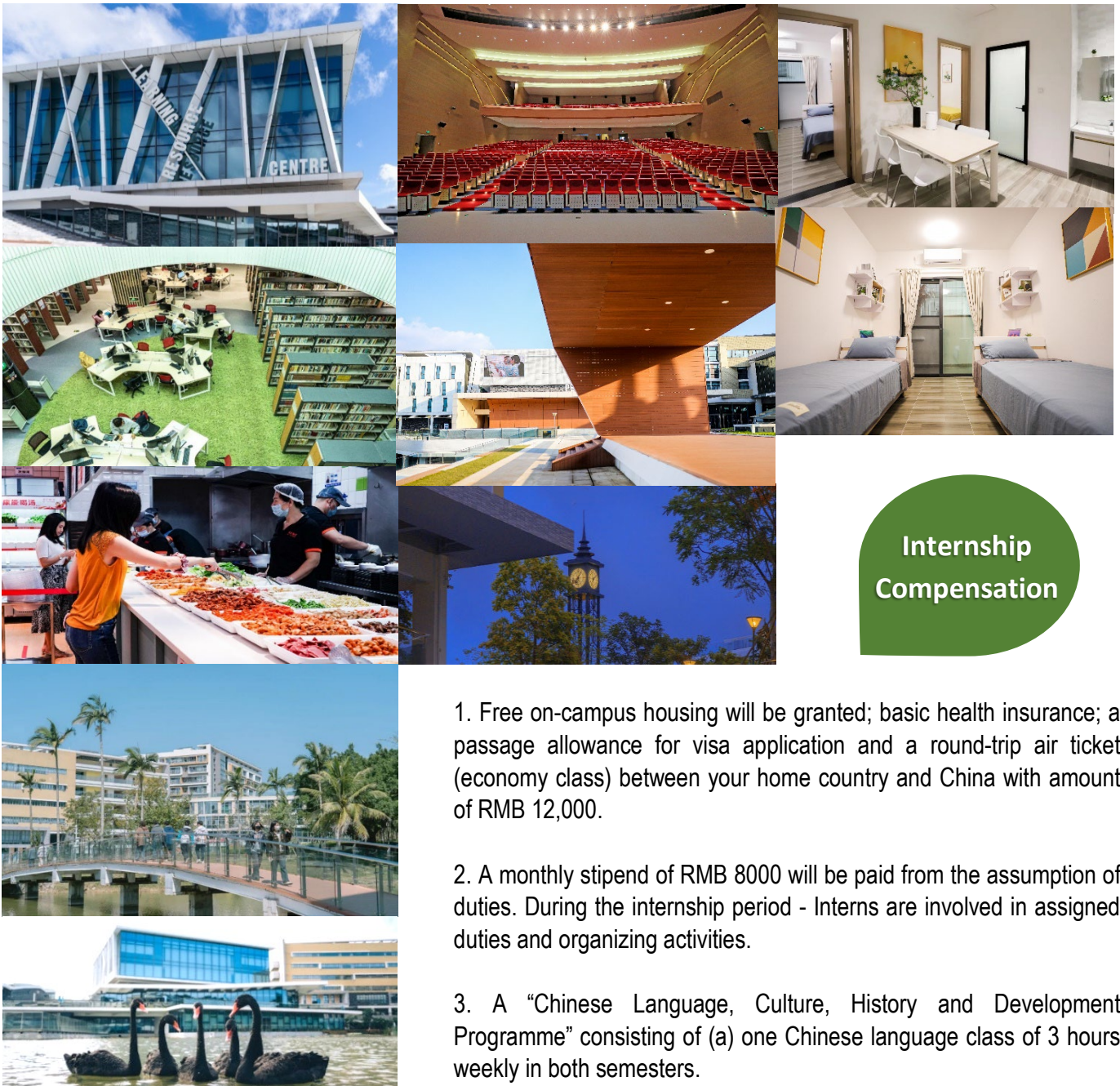

IDO will be your first point of contact.

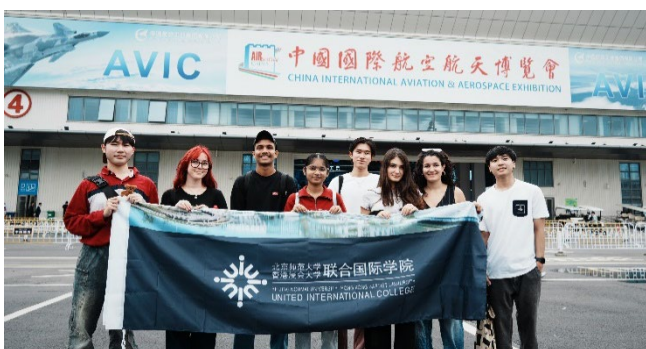

HOW TO APPLY

Application Requirements

1. Successful completion of a Bachelor's degree in any relevant programme (please provide a scanned copy of the graduation certificate). Meet at least a standard of 7.0 IELTS or equivalent if the applicant is from a non-English speaking country.
2. A full transcript of academic work completed with a minimum overall GPA of 3.0.
3. Two letters of recommendation from academic staff or professional supervisor supporting the application.
4. A full personal resume including an expression of interest in a position in a specific department or unit. The applicant should articulate the skills and experience he/she would bring to this specific.
5. Additional information on activities, working experiences, travel and special strengths including computer/technology skills which are important in assuming the role of an Intern.
6. Agreement to enrol in the "Chinese Language, Culture, History and Development Programme" (see point 3 of Compensation for the Intern Position at BNBU below for details) offered by the Centre for Chinese Language and Culture (CLCC) at BNBU during year of residence.
7. Applicants will be interviewed by a panel, consisting of a faculty/school/ unit representative, one HRO representative, and one IDO representative and the list of recommended applicants will be submitted for final endorsement by AVPI, as well as HRO.
8. All applicants need to sign a contract with HRO.

Visa

The type of visa you apply for will depend on the specific details of your placement. The International Development Office will work with you in this process. Once IDO has indicated the type of visa for which you should apply, visit the Chinese Embassy in your country and begin the process.

Please make sure your passport meets the following requirements:

- Valid for at least 6 months after your planned return date when finished the internship.
- Sufficient blank pages for all necessary visas and entry/exit stamps.

Long term study visa (X1) issued to those who study in China for more than 6 months, which must go through residential formalities in the local Entry-Exit Administration of Public Security Bureau within 30 days of entry into China. IDO will assist you to change X1 visa to Residence Permit after your arrival.
