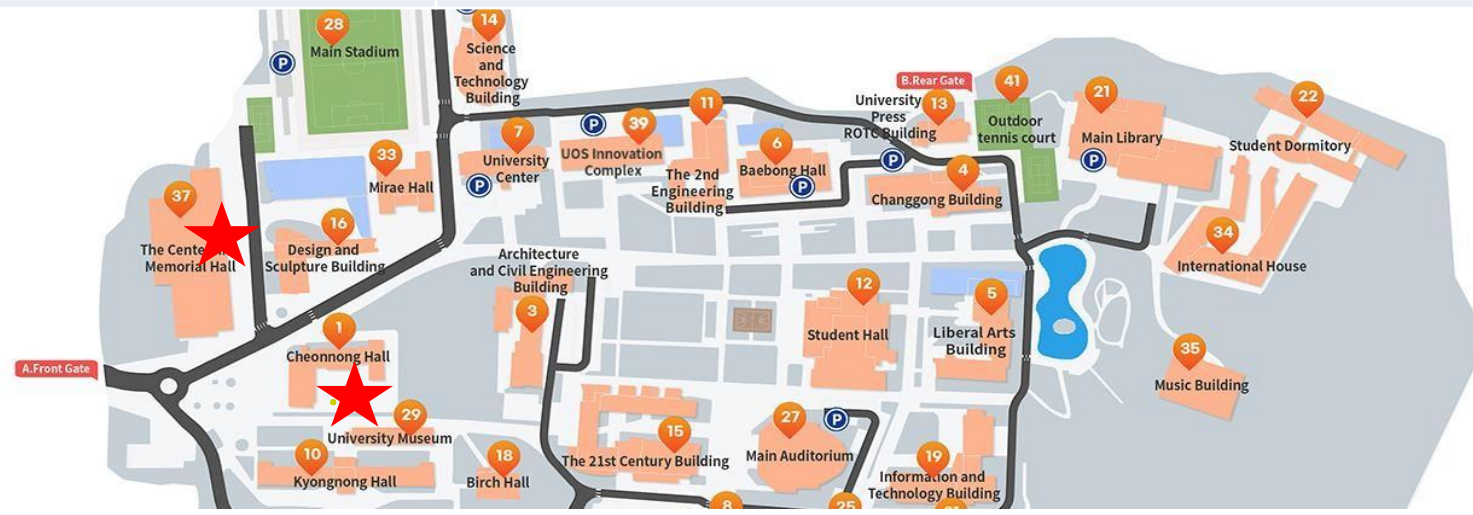

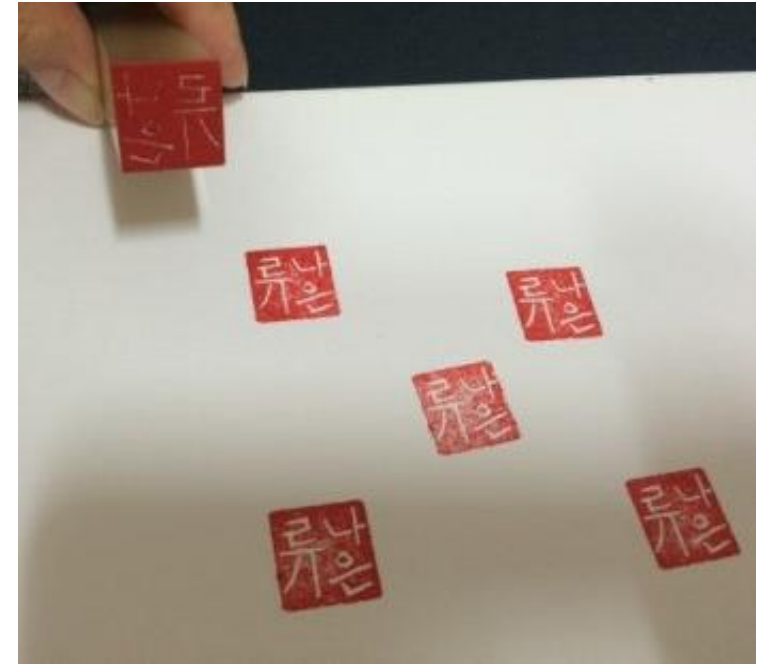

DIY Korean Name Seal (Dojang) Making Experience

Each participant will receive a personal stone seal and learn the art of Jeongak (Seal Engraving) to carve your own Korean name seal.

What is Jeongak (Seal Engraving)?

Jeongak is the traditional art of carving characters or designs onto a seal. The term originates from the practice of engraving Chinese seal script (Jeonseo) onto stone, wood, or other materials to create personal stamps and artistic seals.

Taekwondo : Korea's Traditional Martial Art (July 22)



Taekwondo is Korea's most famous traditional martial art and an official Olympic sport. It emphasizes discipline, respect, self-control, and perseverance while developing physical fitness and mental strength. You will have the opportunity to learn basic techniques, practice kicking skills, and experience Korean martial arts culture firsthand.

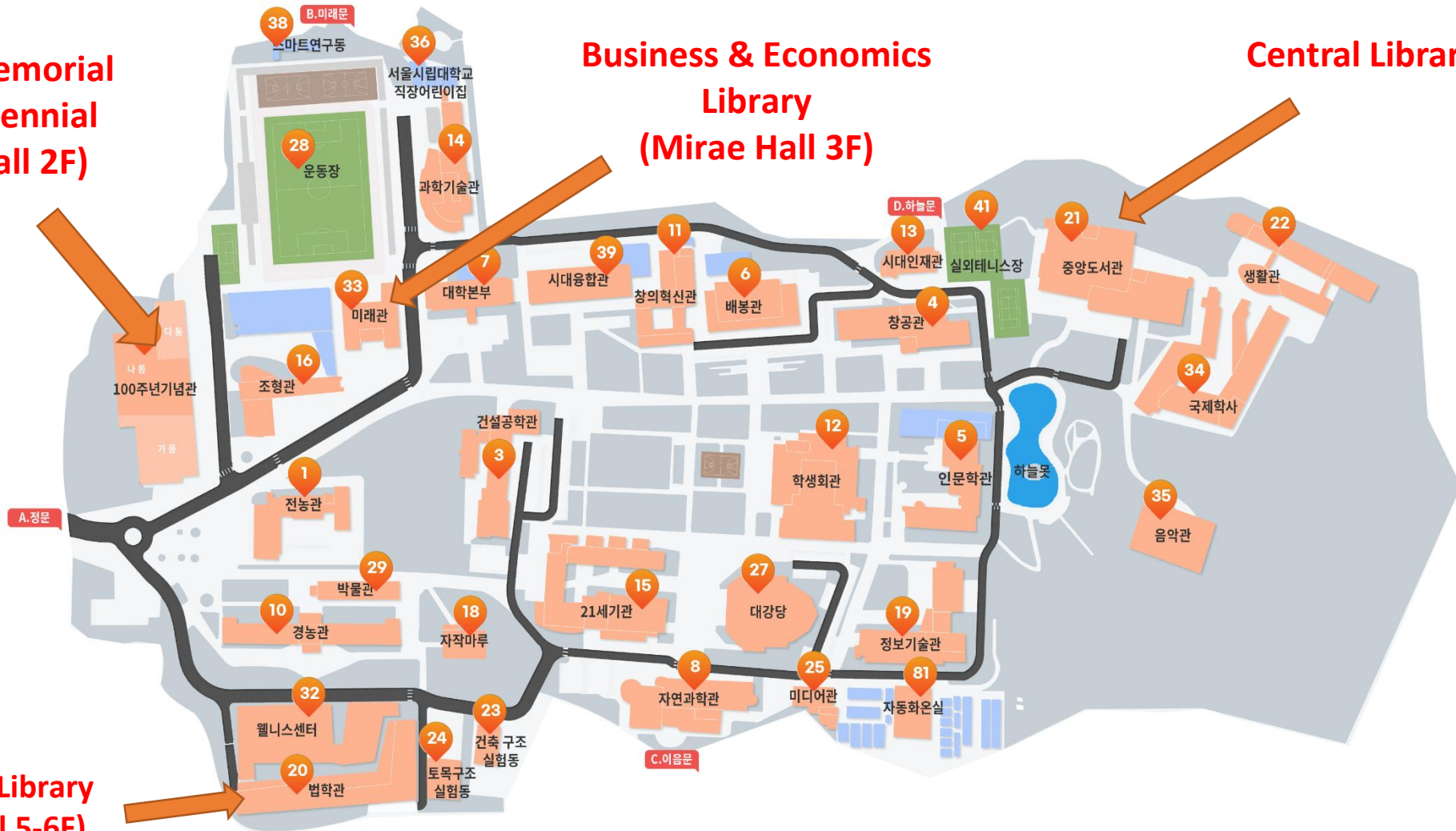
